Fast Track Fire Sprinkler Permit process is intended to expedite the permitting process for alterations, additions, or modifications of projects with twenty (20) fire sprinkler heads or less for each automatic fire sprinkler system riser. To utilize the process, the scope of work must meet the following criteria:

- A copy of this application shall be available at the site and;
- The scope of work is for twenty (20) heads or less for each automatic fire sprinkler system riser and;
- The work has no effect on the hydraulic calculations and;
- The work is not a part of a new system and;
- No welded piping, fittings or appliances are used and;
- All work is visible and easily accessible to the Fire Safety Inspector and;
- No work will be in an area designated as a High Hazard (NFPA 13 Definition) area and;
- All applicable permits and fees must be obtained and paid at the applicable Building Department.
- All work will be performed in accordance with current addition of the **Florida Fire Prevention Code, NFPA 13 Installation of Sprinkler Systems, NFPA 13D Standard for the Installation of Fire Sprinkler Systems in One- and Two-Family Dwellings and Manufactured Home, NFPA 13R Standard for the Installation of Fire Sprinkler Systems in Residential Occupancies Up to and Including Four Stories in Height** or any other applicable Laws, Standards or Codes.
- After the work is completed, a Fire Inspector must perform an inspection. Call Citrus County Fire Rescue at (352)527-5407 for an appointment.**

If a Fire Inspector determines that any one the conditions cannot or was not met, then a full set of plans and the required information will be submitted for a complete review.
