See additional pages for information that is required for an application submittal. An incomplete application and/or the lack of required information will be cause for an unaccepted application.

ALL required documentation shall be delivered to the Fire Prevention Office in accordance with Florida Statute 791.02(1) at least 15 days prior to the display date. INCOMPLETE OR LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Lack of information is considered to be an incomplete application and will not be accepted.

NFPA 1123 (2006 edition) Code for Fireworks Display

Information necessary for a permit application and review:

- Completed *Fireworks Permit* application.
- Property information for any property that may be effected by the display, name of owner, etc. Include letters of acknowledgements from the owners of any dwellings, buildings or structures within the display site stating that they are aware of and approve of the display and will not occupy the buildings during the display.
- Provide a plan of how the spectators are going to be kept away from the discharge site.
- Current *Certificate of Insurance*. Display date must be between the policy effective dates!
- Copy of ATF License/Permit.

Site plan (as close to scale as possible) shall have the following:

- Show all properties that are associated with the display.
- Provide dimensions of the discharge site.
- Show spectator viewing and parking areas. Include types of barriers that will be used.
- Show fallout area and provide separation distances.
- When trenches or holes are dug, the location of any underground utilities or other important equipment must be shown.
- Show any healthcare, detention, or correctional facilities within twice the allowable display area dimension.
- Show location of all mortars or ground pieces.
- Show overhead objects (power lines, trees and their limbs, etc.) that are on the subject properties. Show distance to nearest overhead hazard.
- Show locations of required fire protection and Fire Department staging area. If launching from a vessel:

- Describe vessel.
- Any motors or fuel tanks on board?
- Will the vessel be occupied? If so, it must have a safety shelter for the occupants. Show construction and details of the safety shelter.
- Distance between mortars and safety shelter.
- Manual or electrically fired?
- Does the vessel and fireworks display and operation meet the requirements of NFPA 1123 Chapter 6?
- All personnel must have properly fitting personal flotation devices (PFD). Devices shall be worn while the vessel is not moored at the dock. PFD's shall have or include visual location devices immediately available.
